Statement of Faith

Cornerstone Foundation (Australia) Inc. is a Christian, inter-denominational, non-profit organisation, registered as an incorporated body in Adelaide, 31 May 2000.

Membership includes Christians from all walks of life who share one common goal:
“to help orphaned Ugandan teenagers in desperate need”.

The Foundation believes that every child deserves the provision of daily food, basic clothing, medical attention and educational training based on Biblical Christian principles and values. Our aim is to establish a “Vocational Training Centre”, to give complete care for children living in poverty and fear in Northern Uganda, in a war zone devastated by AIDS. The purpose of the training centre will be to equip orphans with practical, vocational skills that will enable them to survive, and become “self sufficient”.

In response to the scripture from James 1:27 that forms the basis of the Foundation’s ministry, we seek to bring the love of Jesus to orphans in Kitgum (Northern Uganda) in a very practical way, enabling them to look to the future with new hope, and break the cycle of poverty and despair.

Statement of Faith

We believe in the one, holy, sovereign, creating and redeeming God, eternally existing in three persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

We believe in the joyful prospect of everlasting life in the presence of God for those who have received Christ, and the certainty of everlasting and conscious separation from God for those who have rejected Him.
